Requirements:

- Available for 9 months from March 2022 for five (5) workshops
- Must be a member of the LGBTQI/ Sex Work community
- Must be a Johannesburg resident or able to travel to the workshop venue at either Sisonke's Marshalltown office or GALA office, Braamfontein
- Ability to think creatively
- Interest in writing community stories
